

Requirements for TopRope belaying and climbing

- 1. Know and adhere to the **VSBK climbing rules**.
- 2. Use the <u>correct carabiner</u> when tying in.
- 3. Take <u>weight-compensation measures</u> in case of weight difference between climber and belayer.

BELAYING

- 4. Proper handling of the belay device (installation, brakehand-principle, position of belay device, taking rope).
- 5. Proper conduct while belaying (position, managing rope stretch, avoiding slack).
- 6. Proper conduct in the event of a fall.
- 7. Safe and controlled lowering (brakehand-principle, slow, no grasping above the brake rope).

If you cannot confidently answer "yes" to all of the above points, we recommend <u>basic</u> or further education.

CLIMBING

For toprope climbing, the following rules must be adhered to.

A formal education is not required.

- 1. Agree on commands for "take" and "lower".
- 2. Always climb along the designated line. Avoid swinging when falling.
- 3. Do not grab into bolt hangers and carabiners.
- 4. Adjust your climbing pace to the belayers ability.
- 5. Do not unclip the top anchor.
